

4-H clubs are required to manage their treasury responsibly. The 4-H clubs are not allowed to accumulate excessively large fund balances unless there is a specific project and activity that the 4-H club has identified.

If your 4-H club created their 4-H Club Budget Worksheet and finds they have a balance that exceeds the current and prior year's expenses recorded in the 4-H Club Annual Financial Verification Report, a **Long-Term Spending Plan** is required to be submitted to the Extension Office along with the 4-H Club Treasurer's Book.
