Beginner

- Learn about where llamas/ alpacas come from.
- Identify llamas/alpacas body parts.
- Learn about feeding, health, and daily care.
- Learn how to show your llama/ alpaca.
- Learn about lama uses and careers related to llamas/ alpacas.

Intermediate

- Learn about llama/alpaca communication and characteristics.
- Learn about the differences between llamas, alpacas, and their wild cousins.
- Learn about llama/alpaca anatomy and confirmation.
- Learn about llama/alpaca care and maintenance, and nutrition.
- Learn about skills needed in a llama/alpaca show.
- Learn about selecting llamas/ alpacas for your herd.

Advanced

- Learn about llama/alpaca behaviors and herd hierarchy.
- Learn to compare llamas/ alpacas and evaluate their confirmation.
- Learn about llama/alpaca coat types.
- Learn about llama/alpaca body conditioning.
- Learn about maintaining health records and administering medication.
- Learn about training you llama/ alpaca.

- Host a llama/alpaca clinic with local extension office

Service and Leadership

- Bring your llamas/alpacas to a nursing home or day care to teach others about your project
- Arrange a barn tour

Entrepreneurship

- Sell your llama/alpaca wool to a crafter or fiber
- Create and sell products made from your llama/ alpaca wool
- Partner with a local petting zoo by providing the llama or alpaca

Technology Connection


- Install a barn camera to observe llamas/alpacas in labor
