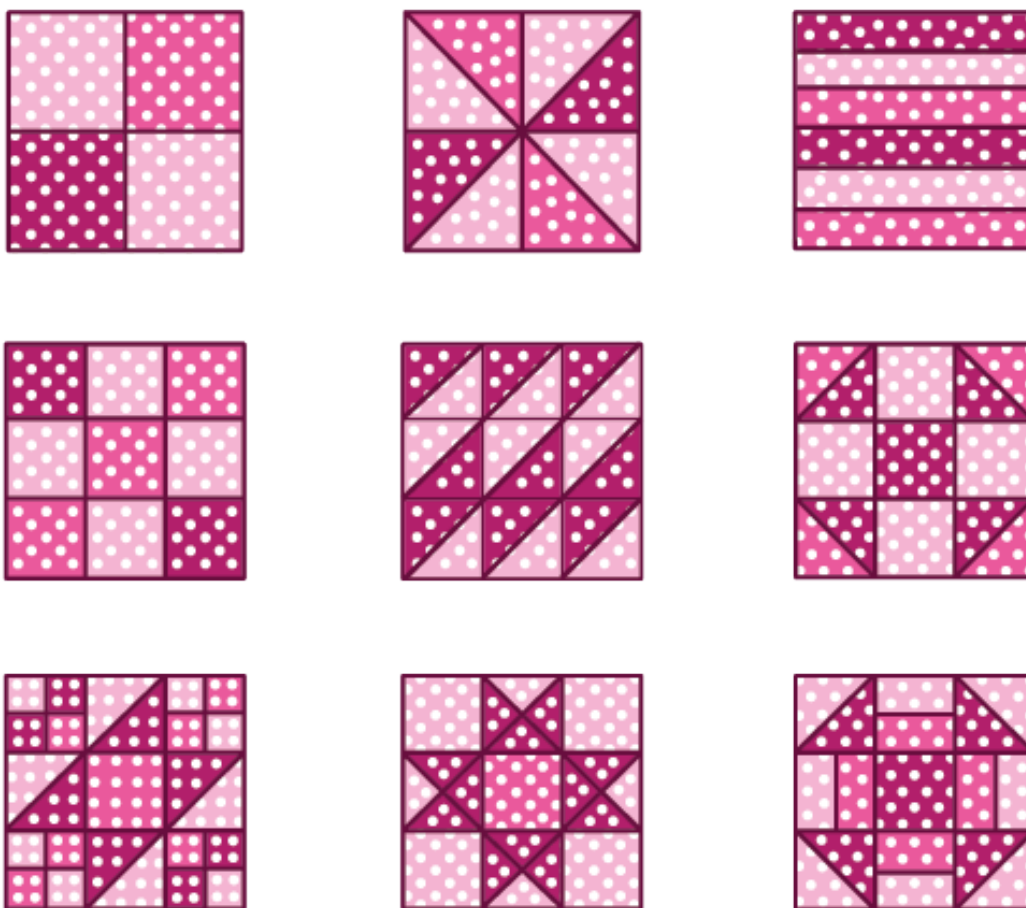




## Design Your Own Quilt Square

Quilt squares are the individual blocks that are used to create a larger quilt pattern. Each block in a quilt can be the same or different. Use the template on the next page to design your own quilt square using colored pencils, markers, or crayons. Look at the example quilt square illustrations on this page to give you ideas for your design. Choose colors that look good together! Don't be afraid to divide each square in the template up into smaller sections (like triangles, smaller squares, or other shapes). If you want, you can use a ruler to help you divide your squares into smaller shapes.
