

Gridwalk



Planning

- 15-30 minutes
- 5-25 participants

Materials

- Gridwalk Tarp
 - 7x7 grid of squares with each square being 1 square foot.
- Gridwalk Map

Instructions

1. One participant on the grid at a time.
2. If the participant steps on the wrong square, the entire group must start over.
3. After stepping on a wrong square, the participant must leave the grid in the exact order in which they entered the grid (basically backwards).
4. If a person doesn't follow the path correctly, they lose their verbal communication for the rest of the activity.
5. After a participant crosses the entire path on the grid with nonverbal communication abilities. We do this so that those students who do not pay any attention must pay the consequences.

Game Play

- The goal for the group is to cross the grid as quickly as possible by following the path on the gridwalk map.

Debrief

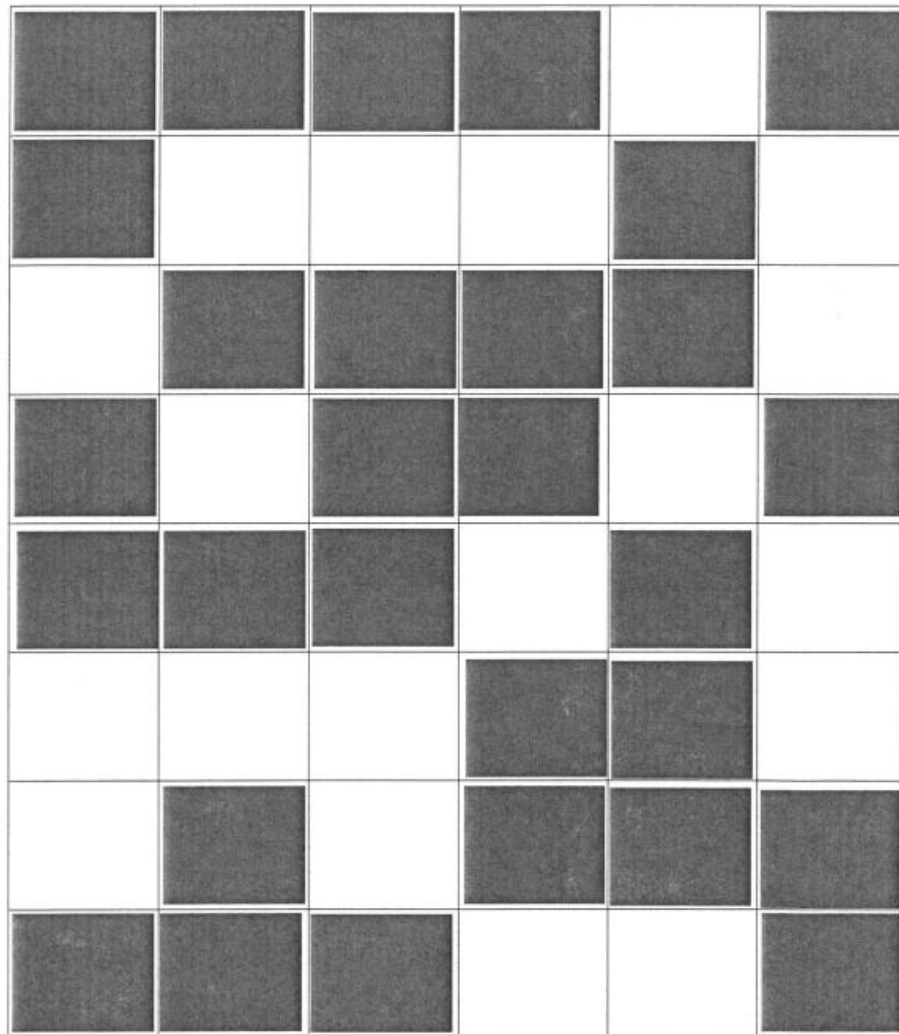
- What was the hardest part?

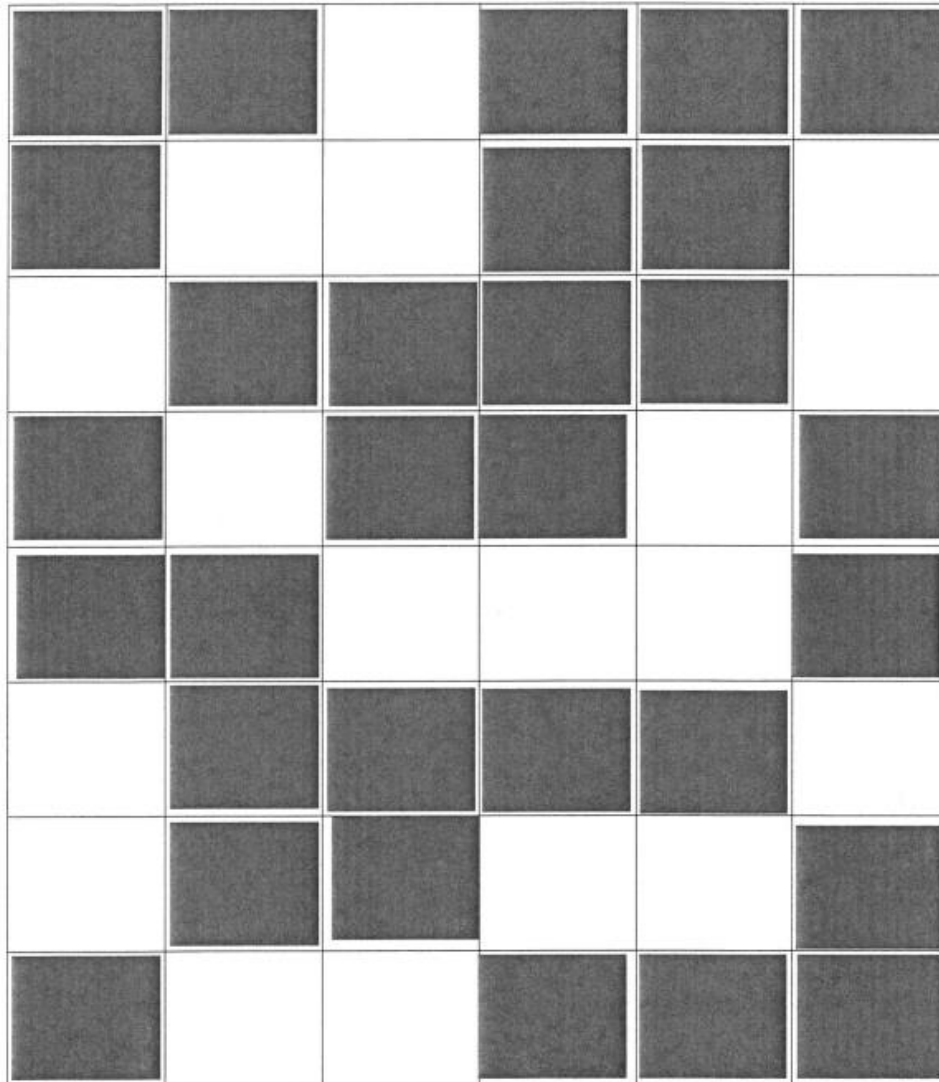

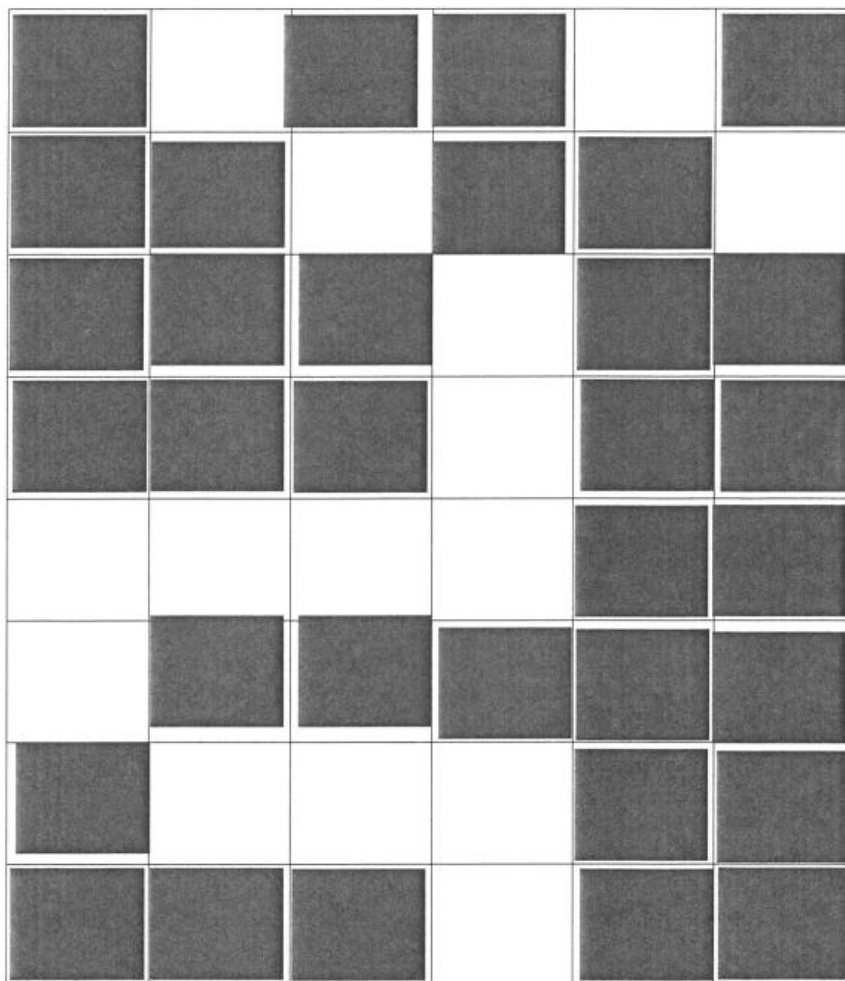
