THE FAIR

FINDING THE ORR BUILDING

Traffic around the State Fair runs in a one-way loop during Fair time. Use the State Fair map in the app or on the State Fair site to scope out parking lots and plan your walking path to the Orr Building.

DROPPING OFF/ PICKING UP

Leave your exhibitor ticket with your project on the table labeled for your project area. There is no need to check in with a person, but before you leave:

- 1. Tear off the bottom half of your exhibitor ticket and take it with you to use as a "claim ticket" for pickup at the end of the day.
- 2. Consult the judging schedule that is in a plastic stand on your project table. Find your name on the list and identify the time you are scheduled to meet with your judge. Plan to arrive back in your project area a few minutes early.
- 3. **Projects can be picked up** as your project area judging is completed until 4:30 pm. Download the event app to get updates on when your project area is ready for pick up.
