



Follow the steps below to locate your Household Member ID number in ZSuite.

# **Finding Your Member ID Steps**

1. Log-in to your family's ZSuite account at https://4h.zsuite.org using your account email and password.



2. On your "Choose Profile" page for your family that comes up after you register, you should see "Household Member ID" numbers listed for each family member after their first name. Copy the individual's number from that screen to use to input for camp registration.



## **Troubleshooting and other locations to find Member ID**

If you are not seeing Household Member ID appear in the location listed, see if you have a pink "UPDATE READY" button appearing on the top of your screen. If you do, click that button to reload the page and push the update. Once you do that the numbers should appear on your screen.

If you are still having issues, here are two other locations you can find the ID.

## **LOCATION ONE**

On the "Choose Profile" screen select the primary account (it should be pink, say the word "Primary" under the name, and appear in the top left corner of this screen).

On the screen that appears, find the Household user box. In this box, click on the carrot to the right of the name of the person you need to get a number for. This will open up details on that user. There you should see the "Household Member ID" number.



## **LOCATION TWO**

Alternately, on the "Choose Profile" screen you can click on the member you are trying to get the Member ID number on. Once you are on that individual's profile dashboard you should see a box (with an animal icon) with that person's basic information. In that box the Household Member ID should be visible to copy.
